

Notes on using the GLN number and requirements for On the way to PlanetProof



- On the way to PlanetProof certificate holders are required to include their unique registration number in the PlanetProof logo. This number is comprised of an abbreviation of the name of the certification body, with a serial number (for example, ABC 1234567)
- If a certificate holder has a subscription to a GLN number, the compulsory mention of the registration number in the On the way to PlanetProof logo on packaging may be omitted, provided the GLN number is shown on the same packaging.
 - Growers with a GLN subscription who operate in the fruit and vegetable sector are advised to use their GLN number for On the way to PlanetProof as well as for GlobalG.A.P.
- Dutch growers, packers, grower cooperatives and trading companies normally use the GS1 Netherlands series. The right to use a GLN starting within the series 870 - 879 has been granted by GS1 Netherlands. The certificate holder is permitted to use a GLN number from the 870-879 series instead of the compulsory mention of the registration number in the On the way to PlanetProof logo. - The only exceptions to this are GLN series starting within the series 4049928 - 4063061, as these numbers almost always originate from the GlobalG.A.P. working organization FoodPLUS GmbH (Spichernstr. 55, 50672 Cologne, Germany). The right to use a GLN number starting within the series 400 - 440 has been granted by GS1 Germany.
