On the way to PlanetProof Sustainability fee 2024 Regulations



How does the sustainability fee work?

The following is a point-by-point explanation of how the sustainability fee works:

- 1. Supermarkets pay their suppliers the sustainability fee for products supplied with the On the way to PlanetProof label. Currently, this applies to unprocessed potatoes, fruit and vegetables.
- 2. The amount of the sustainability fee is the amount per kilogram or pieces of product as published on the On the way to PlanetProof website. See table below with the amounts per product category.
- 3. Suppliers (links in the supply chain, such as trading companies, cooperatives, grower associations) will be required to pass on the full sustainability fee received from supermarkets to farmers and growers who supplied the produce.
- 4. Suppliers supplying participating supermarkets are allowed to make agreements with their member farmers and growers on how the sustainability fee will be distributed.
- 5. The sustainability fee is always shown separately on the settlement or invoice. The method of invoicing may differ per supermarket and supply chain but should at all times be transparent about the amount of the sustainability fee paid per supply chain link.
- 6. The effective date of the scheme is the date of publication of the fee schedule and applies to all new procurement contracts that supermarkets enter into with suppliers. A transition period applies to existing contracts. No later than 1 January 2025, the sustainability fee will apply to all purchases made by participating supermarkets.
- 7. The level of the sustainability fee was determined by SMK, based on independent advice, and is based on average costs and revenues per hectare. For more information on this, the substantiation report can be accessed on the website of planetproof.eu.
- 8. The sustainability fee can be adjusted per calendar year based on the price index and will be recalculated when the requirements of the certification scheme are revised. SMK will always announce this in a timely manner so that supermarkets apply the correct sustainability fee.
- 9. To provide further explanation and answer questions, SMK will organize webinars in the autumn.
- 10. In case of questions or comments, farmers and growers can always contact SMK. The address for this is smk@smk.nl. However, we ask farmers and growers to first consult their supplier if they have questions about a settlement or whether or not they have (fully) received a sustainability payment.
